DESCRIPTION

This training examines the procedure of the Annual Performance Test of JRC's Voyage Data Recorders JCY-1900/1950.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Service engineer is in the possession of (S)-VDR JCY-1900/1950 certificate
- Employer of the service engineer must have a valid, signed high seas dealer agreement with JRC-Americas
- Service engineer must be employed at dealer office in the JRC-Americas support area
- Basic knowledge of Windows
- Understanding of industry standards IEC61162-1 and IEC61162-2
- Advanced understanding of maritime navigation equipment, onboard command & control, engine management and alarm systems
- Service engineer is recommended to have at least one year of field experience

APPLICATION

The engineer can apply for this e-learning by registration on the JRC website.

Please note that it is important to fill in the personal work e-mail address of the engineer.
